Let's take it into our hands!

Here come our tips that help you cut consumption:



Turn down the temperature!

Reduce heating temperature in common areas and during nighttime. An overnight reduction by only 1 degree can save you 10% of energy!



Air seal the building!

Sealing cracks, gaps and leaks and adding insulation will help keep the heat inside and will reduce energy consumption.




Equip the home!

Install programmable thermostats that will automatically adjust the temperature according to your schedule.



Replace your old refrigerator!

Replace the appliance with one with a good energy rating and adjust its size to suit your needs and those of other household members.



Have your heating system inspected!

The installer will check the condition of all appliances, inspect and clean the boiler, chimney or air-flue duct.



Reduce the water pressure in the tap!

Reduce the pressure if there are people in your home who may have difficulty adjusting the water flow to suit their needs.
